Former U.S. Women's Open champion Michelle Wie West is coming out of retirement to compete in the women's version of the tech-infused indoor golf league that was created by Tiger Woods and Rory McIlroy, organizers said on Monday.

Wie West, who exited professional golf in 2023 after a career that included five LPGA Tour wins, is a limited partner of TGL's Los Angeles Golf Club team that consists of Collin Morikawa, Tommy Fleetwood, Justin Rose and Sahith Theegala.

"I'm excited for the chance to compete again through WTGL, which will be a powerful platform for women's golf," Wie West, a five-time U.S. Solheim Cup team member said in a TMRW press release.
